Warning: do not put items outside before clean up day. Store items in your home or shed. Can't wait? Walter's in Blaine has a drop off service for a fee. Or check out the disposal option on the back page from John. Only Colonial Village residents may participate in this clean up.

APRIL IS SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS MONTH

The time to plan is now, before an emergency arises. Colonial Village has a storm shelter located at 5700 Squire Lane. When you moved into Colonial you were given a "shelter plan". The plan encourages you to stay alert for public warnings, plan ahead on what you will do, and if the media advises, take shelter.

- >Don't be taken by surprise. Be aware of potential severe weather.
- >Purchase a NOAA weather radio. The models out today can be set with an alarm to go off if a warning is issued specifically in your area. There are weather apps for your phone that will send out warning texts also.
- >Allow plenty of time to move to the shelter and bring a portable radio with you.
- >Arrange for those who need assistance. Someone whose mobility is impaired may need help and thought should be given for a plan for them.
- >Children home alone need to know what to do in severe weather. Children also should be taught to go home if they hear the sirens while out playing.
- >Pets brought to the shelter must be adequately restrained. Plan ahead. The shelter is locked to avoid vandalism but is opened at the first sign of threatening weather. **Some families in Colonial Village are "key holders" for the shelter. If you would like information on this please call the Community office.**

Peanut Butter Rice Krispie Bars

Butter a 9x13 pan
Put in a large bowl:
6 cups Rice Krispies



In a small saucepan bring to a light boil:
1 cup sugar
1 cup light Karo syrup
1 ½ cups peanut butter

Pour over the cereal and stir well. Pour in the 9x13 pan and pat down. Butter your hands if it is sticky.

Mounds View Compost Site Opens April 1st

The compost site for your leaves and grass is located at Ardan Park: Long Lake Road and Ardan Ave., about a mile west of here. (Take Hillview west to Long Lake Rd. and turn right. The compost site is about 2 blocks north) There is no charge to use the compost site. You drive in, empty the bags and take them home again for reuse or disposal.

**Hours are Mondays, Wednesdays,
Fridays 11 a.m.-7 p.m. Saturdays 9 a.m.-5
p.m. Sundays 11 a.m.-5 p.m. Closed
Tuesdays, Thursdays and holidays.**

Bags of leaves and grass may not be stored in your yard (It is a Health Code violation)
The area behind the shelter is NOT for leaves or grass disposal.

There is a local and affordable alternative for disposing of large items. Items such as mattresses or appliances can be VERY expensive to dispose of. Mattress disposal curbside is \$55 and appliances are \$66. Mattresses on Clean Up Day will be \$45.

On the 3rd Saturday of every month there is "Recycling Saturday" at Green Lights Recycling in Blaine from 8:00-12:00. Mattresses are \$20 each and appliances are \$15. They also accept items not allowed at Clean Up day such as TV's, A/C's, and tires. You must transport the items to the facility and there can be a line to wait. Google "Monthly Recycling Saturdays Blaine" for a complete list of accepted items and pricing. You do not have to be a Blaine resident to participate.
