Jayne's Creamy Fudge

1-1/2 c. sugar

1/2 c. butter or margarine
1 small can evaporated milk-about 2/3 c.
1 7 oz. jar marshmallow creme
3 cups semisweet chocolate chips
1/2 tsp. vanilla

Lightly grease foil lined 9x9x2 inch pan. Set aside. Heat sugar, butter, milk, and marshmallow creme in heavy 3 quart saucepan over medium heat until mixture boils, stirring constantly for 5 minutes. Remove from burner and add chocolate chips and vanilla - stirring until chips are melted. At this point you may add 2 cups chopped walnuts if desired. Immediately spread in prepared pan. Refrigerate over night. Cut into 1 inch pieces. Store in airtight container in refrigerator. Makes 4 pounds

From John.... the Colonial Repair Guy!



Do you need to shut off the water to your home? Some homes have a whole house valve built into the wall and labeled (do not confuse this with the clothes washer valves).

The next place to check is your water heater compartment. Frequently there is a whole house shut off here.

There is also a main shut off under your home, where the water line comes out of the ground. A "ball valve" has a bar handle that is turned 1/4 turn to shut off the valve. A "gate valve" has a round handle that is turned multiple times to turn off the valve. If you have a gate valve, please contact the CV office as there is an extra step to take when turning this on. These valves are CV property and any issues should be reported to the Community office.

Remember: if the water will be off for an extended amount of time, flip off the breaker to your electric water heater.
