We are looking for someone who is willing to pick up items for dumpster day at resident's homes and bring the items up to the dumpster. We will hand out your phone number and you can negotiate price for the service. Some neighbor's don't have hauling ability. Call the office if you are willing to help.

## SPRING CLEANUP DAY

The Colonial Village spring clean up day is **Saturday, May 13th from 8am- noon** (Rain or Shine).

Colonial Village provides large dumpsters so that you can do your spring cleaning and dispose of large items **AT NO CHARGE!** (see box for mattress charge) The dumpsters will be located in the parking lot behind the office. Only Colonial Village residents may participate in this clean up. The costs of this service continue to escalate so please only bring items from your household. Note the list of items we can not accept.

We will have a one way street to the dumpsters; one vehicle at a time. Please wait until the person leaves before pulling ahead.

**Metal Curbside Pick Up Friday**

Curbside pick up of some larger metal items is available the day before cleanup on Friday, May 12th. **RESERVATIONS REQUIRED!** You must call the Colonial Village Office to be put on the pick up list. Items include ranges, dishwashers, washers, dryers, water heaters, BBQ grills, lawn mowers, snowblowers, bikes, computer towers and hard drives, miscellaneous metal. These items must be outside by 9:00am the morning of May 12th. Please do not put anything out before then as it would be a health code violation. Other debris must be brought to the dumpsters on

## Rhubarb Strawberry Crunch

- 1 cup white sugar
- 3 Tbsp flour
- 3 cups sliced strawberries
- 3 cups diced rhubarb



Combine and place in a 9 x 13" baking dish.

- 1½ cups flour
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 cup butter
- 1 cup oatmeal

Mix and crumble on top of the rhubarb strawberry mixture. Bake at 375° for 45 minutes (or until lightly browned)

***A: Household Hazardous waste:***

old chemicals, leftover paint, fluorescent bulbs, etc. can be brought to HHW facility for free. 3230 101st Ave NE, Blaine. 763-323-5730.

**Electronics Refrigerators, A/C's:** Recycling Technologies 10040 Davenport, Blaine 763-785-0456. Call for hours and pricing.

**Tires:** Any tire retailer must take tires for recycling. There will be a charge.

**Branches:** Branches may be brought to the bin behind the storm shelter. **No grass or leaves may be dumped behind the storm shelter. Only branch disposal.**

**Leaves and grass:** can be brought to the compost site for free. 8307 Long Lake Road; open every day except Tuesday & Thursday.
